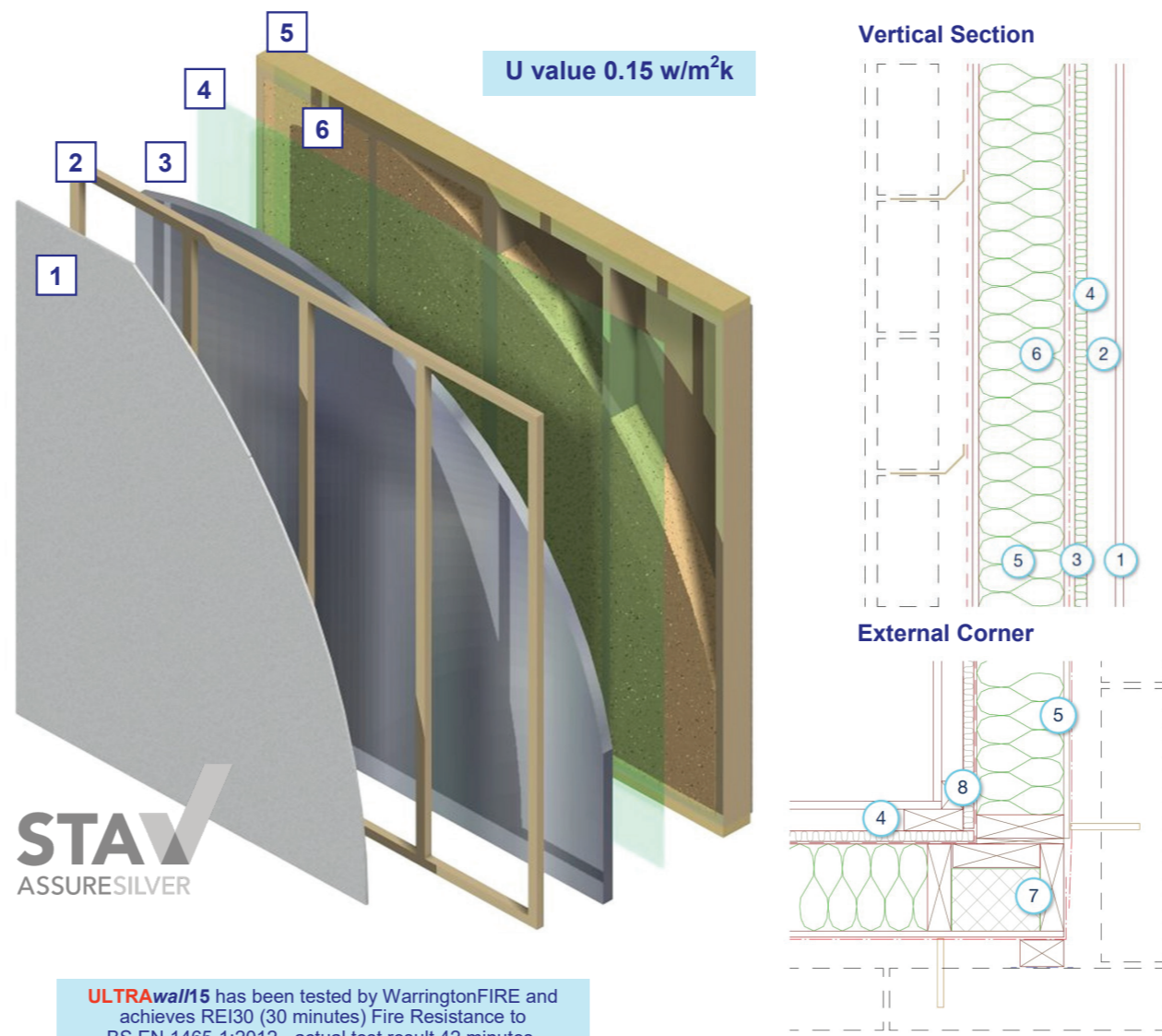

50mm thick : Overall wall U value 0.12w/m²k
